

The PASIFIC programme is open to researchers of any nationality from across all scientific disciplines. We offer attractive **2-year fellowships** at one of the Polish Academy of Sciences (PAS) institutes.

You have the **freedom to choose a Host Institute**, scientific supervisor, and secondment organizations best suited to your individual research and career development. Up to 50 Fellows will be recruited in two calls:

Why apply?

- the chance to benefit from comprehensive mentoring and training, providing a variety of developmental opportunities
- expert supervision of your individual research project and the chance to build a Career Development Plan defining long-term goals and research directions
- access to numerous training sessions and workshops on such issues as funding opportunities in Poland and Europe
- the possibility of spending up to 6 months in the non-academic sector or short visits to research and non-academic organizations worldwide

As a PASIFIC Fellow you will receive a monthly **allowance of approx.** €2,500 net plus an additional **research budget of up to €93,000** per project. If you relocate to Poland with your family, you may be entitled to receive an additional **family allowance**.

Who can apply?

- researchers of any nationality
- researchers representing all scientific disciplines
- researchers with a PhD or at least 4 years of Full-Time Equivalent research experience
- researchers who have not resided or carried out their main activity in Poland for more than one year out of the three years prior to the call's deadline

How to apply?

Before applying, you need to identify a suitable PAS institute and a prospective supervisor who will commit to support your research. Please find more information on the website: **pasific.pan.pl**

In cooperation with the prospective supervisor and Host Institute you should prepare an application to be submitted to the online system. The application consists of an online administrative form and the following attachments:

- CV and scientific track record
- description of the research project (max. 10 pages)
- prospective supervisor's CV to be prepared together with representatives of the Institute
- ethics self-assessment (if necessary)
- scanned PhD diploma or documents confirming the equivalent 4-year research experience
- scanned letter confirming support from the prospective supervisor and Host Institution
